He doesn't have any grievance, but he prayed to take him back into the institution for studies, He said all this issues happened only when he is with companion. he assured he will be a moral student. His mother also plead the same to give him a last and final chance. Mr. Rinu sunny submitted the above in writing, to the chairman of Grievance Redressal Committee.

Later, Rev. Fr. Cherian T Samuel, Parish Priest of Mr. Rinu sunny & Member of management committee of the Orthodox church, met the grievance committee. He assured that he will take care and will have constant touch with Mr. Rinu sunny, He said he counselled him and was observing him for the past 15 days, he was able to recognize changes in his character and turning towards a good life.

Being only in second year, Mr. Rinu sunny has already received three suspensions, continuously being involved in disciplinary issues, academic performance is very poor and have continuous attendance shortage in previous semesters, wherein all the above information is very well known to his parent. the only positive observation noted is, the information shared by the parish priest. Based on the above comments council may take decision, also positive observation given by the parish priest may be deliberated.
