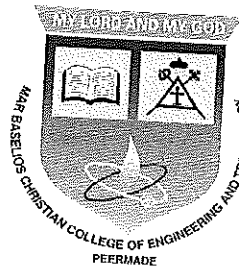

The IQAC cell of MBCCET organized an FDP on Revised Assessment and Accreditation framework on 16<sup>th</sup> February 2019 for all the faculty members of MBCCET, Peermade. The college is doing the works for the Accreditation and this programme was meant to understand the procedures of the NAAC Accreditation process. The class was led by, **Dr. Suby Babu, Assistant Professor of Nirmala college of Arts and Science, Muvattupuzha**. The programme had 3 different sessions to explain the seven criteria for the Accreditation process. All the faculty members attended the programme. The response of the faculty was too positive till the end of the programme which manifested the success of the programme.

#### **AIM**

The one-day faculty development programme was arranged to understand the objectives and procedures of the NAAC accreditation process according to the new regulations from January 2019. This was an opportunity for the faculty to clarify queries and doubts regarding the process of NAAC Accreditation process.

#### **INAUGURATION**

The inaugural ceremony of the programme was held at PTA Seminar hall on 16th February 2019 at 9.00 am. Dr. Anoop KJ (Dean, Academics) welcomed the gathering and introduced the Chief resource person, Dr. Suby Babu. Dr. Suby Babu inaugurated the one day faculty development programme. The principal of the institution presided over the meeting. There was also the presence of Rev. Fr. Kuruvilla Perummal Chacko (Students' Advisor) and Dr. Nirmala Joseph (Dean, Student Affairs).

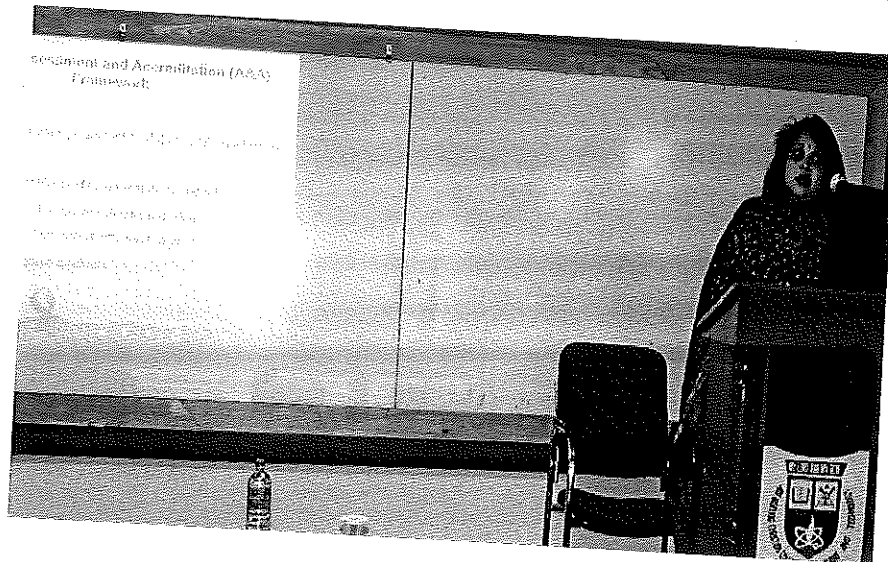

### **PROGRAMME DETAILS:**

#### **Session 1: (9.45 am- 11 am)**

The session 1, was all about restructuring in the NAAC Accreditation process. The session dealt with significance of the SSR uploaded which makes 70% of the score which is system generated and rest 25% on the peer team visit and student satisfactory survey. She handled a few topics like IIQA application process, SSR preparation, Student satisfactory survey, system generated assessment, peer team visit, evaluation and accreditation. She mentioned the significance of the website and formation of the minority cells in the college.

Then the first topic of discussion was Criterion 1- the Curricular aspects (100 points) which included curricular planning and implementation, academic flexibility and curricular enrichment which was found to be positive for our college since we have so much changes in our curriculum since we have changed from MG university courses to APJ Abdul Kalam Technological university courses. Here also the Feedback system was discussed. Then we went for a tea break.



### **Session 2(11.15 am- 12.45pm)**

Here the class was all about Criterion 2-Teaching, Learning and Evaluation, Criterion 3- Research, Innovations and Extension, Criterion 4- Infrastructure and learning process. She stressed on the Teaching learning process as it has got maximum points of 230. She also addressed research activities to be conducted in the college and the infrastructure facilities needed for the institution before going for accreditation.

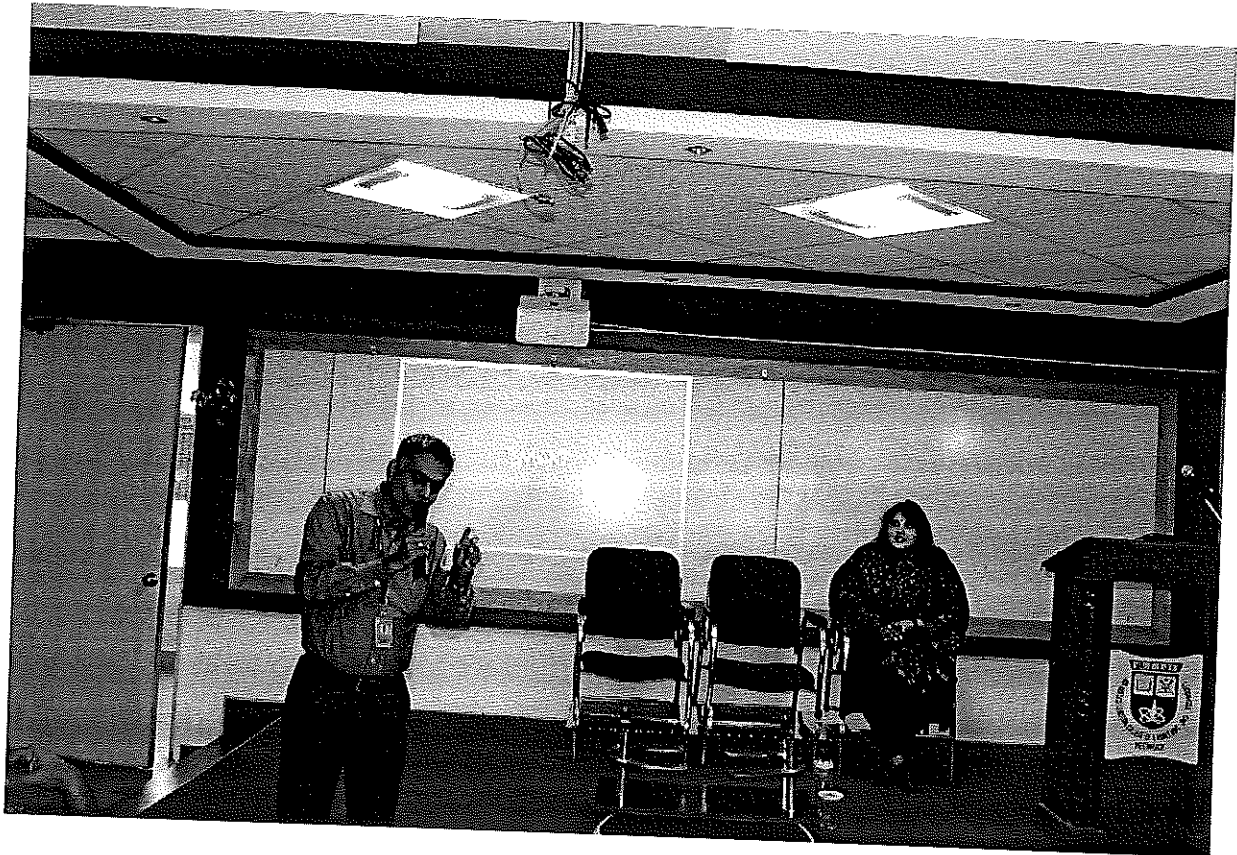
### **Session 3 (1.30 pm- 3.30 pm)**

After the lunch break, the class was all about Criterion 5-Student support and progression, Criterion 6- Governance, Leadership and management and Criterion 7-Institution values and practises. In criterion 5, she stressed on the extra guidance given to students for competitive exams and many more. In Criterion 6, all the implementation of e-governance in the areas of operation and so on were discussed. In Criterion 7, forming a best practise in our college was mostly asked to be done.
