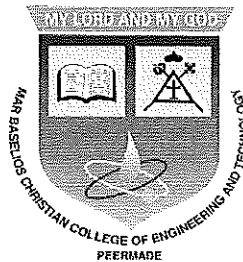

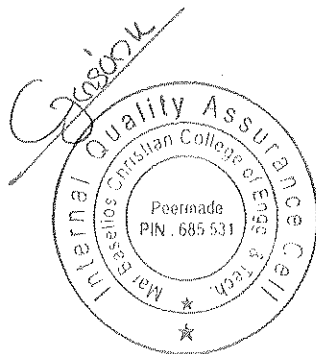


FEEDBACK
