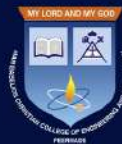

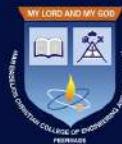

## Rules & Regulations :

### *Project Presentation*

- > ID card is necessary for all the participants.
- > Maximum of 4 students per project will be allowed.
- > Students need to specify the stream of their project before the Expo.
- > The model should be in a good working condition (prototype & semi prototype) and the students must bring their necessary accessories. (General purpose equipment such as power supply will be provided.)
- > At the time of presentation, students are requested to submit a hard copy of the abstract.
- > The prizes will be awarded based on the presentation, viva and model presentation.
- > Decision of judges will be final

### *Poster Presentation*

- > ID card is necessary for all the participants.
- > Maximum of 4 students per project will be allowed.
- > Only one poster will be allowed to present per team.
- > Names and Institute name should appear on the backside of the poster.
- > All lettering and diagrams should be large enough to be read from a minimum of 2 feet.
- > The official language for the poster will be English.
- > Poster Size: maximum 1m x 1m (Printed or Hand Made).
- > Marks will be based on theme, creativity, efforts taken, scientific content and presentation.
- > Decision of judges will be final

### *Idea Presentation*

- > ID card is necessary for all the participants.
- > Maximum of 4 students per project will be allowed.
- > Based on topics, 10 min presentation and 5 min Q & A
- > The prizes will be awarded based on the presentation and viva
- > The official language for the presentation will be English.
- > Decision of judges will be final
