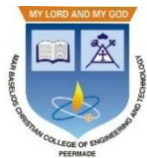

INAUGURAL CEREMONY AND TECHNICAL TALK



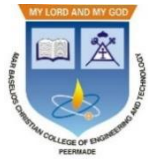

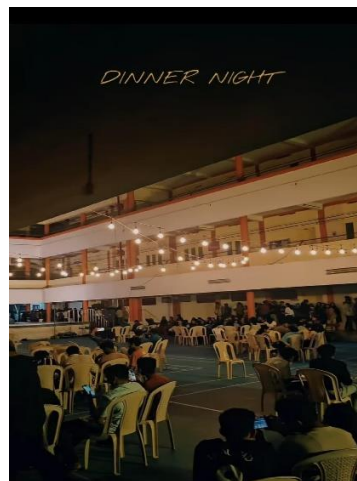

thinking among the AI student community. The launch marked the beginning of a new chapter for the department, focused on student-led initiatives, events, and collaborative growth.

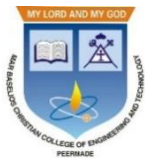
EVENING CELEBRATIONS
