

## **Alumni Feedback on Curriculum Report**











## Teachers Feedback on Curriculum Report Academic Year 2014-2015


The faculty of MBCCET, Peermade gives valuable opinion about the syllabus and academic atmosphere of the institution. Around sixty seven percent considered—that the syllabus is need based. The aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to teachers and students, fifty seven percent faculty members agreed to the above mentioned questionnaire. The course/syllabus has good balance between theory and application; fifty seven percent agreed and forty three percent disagree the above statement. Around seventy one percent faculty members supported that the books prescribed/listed as reference materials are relevant, updated and appropriate as per the university. The environment in the department is conducive to teaching and research as well as eighty six percent supported to the statement. Tests and examinations are conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus—ninety five percent responded positively to the statement. Almost all the faculty members supported that infrastructural facilities, such as teacher's rooms, class rooms, reading rooms and toilets are available in the Department and no other grievances were recorded. 





