The survey shows that about forty percent students supported that the syllabus of the courses that they have studied is according to the depth. Almost forty-eight percent of the students have rated a very good response to the syllabus was carrier oriented. Forty -eight percent of students have rated a good response on the sequence of units in the syllabus. 






















Parents Feedback on Curriculum Report Academic Year 2015-2016


